Recycling

Recycling is the process of collecting and processing old materials that can be turned into new products. It helps the community and the environment.

A lot of benefits come from recycling: it reduces the amount of garbage sent to landfills; it conserves natural resources; it helps prevent air, land, and water pollution; it saves energy; and it helps reduce greenhouse gases.

The recycling process has three steps, which create a continuous cycle, represented by the recycling symbol: collection and processing, manufacturing, and buying new products made from recycled materials.
