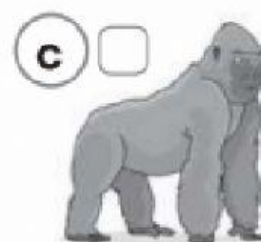
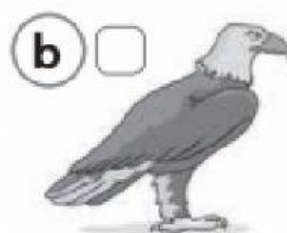
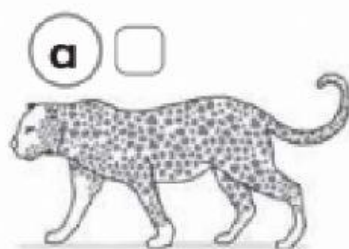
## African Wildlife
