

# SHOULD AND COULD

Should and could are auxiliary verbs that can be defined as past tenses of shall, and can

1. Could is used to talk about something that can happen
2. Should is used to talk about something that must (debe) happen

The equivalent of could in Spanish is: podría

example: I **could** eat an entire cake

Yo **podría** comer un pastel entero

The equivalent of should in Spanish is: debería

example: We **should** go to bed early

Nosotros **deberíamos** ir a la cama temprano
