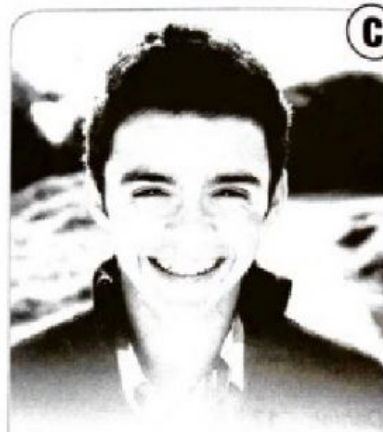
**Klaus**
