**A**

At the age of 14 years, a friend of his father who called Tjokroaminoto, invited Sukarno to stay in Surabaya and schooled in Hoogere Burger School (HBS) with a Koran in the Tjokroaminoto. At Surabaya, Sukarno met with the SI leaders, the organization led by Tjokroaminoto. Sukarno then joined the organization Jong Java (Java Youth).

**B**

Soekarno was Indonesia's first president who served two terms, from 1945 to 1966. He played an important role for the liberation of Indonesia from Dutch colonialism. He is a digger Pancasila and was proclaimed Indonesian independence (along with Mohammad Hatta) which occurred on August 17, 1945. In 1967, President Sukarno removed from office as president in the MPRS Special Session of the same year and raised Suharto as acting President of the Republic of Indonesia. Soekarno died in Jakarta, June 21, 1970 at age 69 years.

**C**

Ir. Soekarno was born in Blitar, East Java, June 6, 1901. He was born with the name Kusno Sosrodihardjo. His father name was Raden Soekemi Sosrodihardjo, a teacher in Surabaya, East Java. His mother was Ida Ayu Nyoman Rai who came from Buleleng, Bali.

**D**

Finished H.B.S. in 1920, Sukarno continued to Technische Hoge School (now ITB) in Bandung, and graduated in 1925. While in Bandung, Sukarno interacted with Tjipto Mangunkusumo and Dr. Douwes Dekker, who was then leader of the National organization Indische Partij.

**E**

In his childhood he was often sick, so he was cared for by his older brother, Raden Hardjodikromo, in Tulungagung. After living with his older brother, in 1909 **Soekarno** returned to his parents' house in Mojokerto. In Mojokerto, his father was assigned as head of the Eerste Inlandse School (ELS) and Soekarno also attended school there. Since living back with his parents, he changed his name from Koesno to **Soekarno** so that he would not be sickly and could grow up healthy.
