

Division Review

Remember, division and multiplication can be seen as “opposite” or inverse operations. You can use your multiplication facts to help you with your multiplication.

$$5 \times 4 = 20 \rightarrow 20 \div 5 = 4$$
$$\text{or } \rightarrow 20 \div 4 = 5$$

So if dividing 20 by 5, we can use our 5 times tables. We know that $5 \times 4 = 20$, so the answer will be 4
