## Song Lyric



### 1. Definition

A song is a single (and often standalone) work of music intended to be sung by the human voice with distinct and fixed pitches and patterns using sound and silence and a variety of forms that often include the repetition of sections.

### 2. Social Function of Song

**In general**, we can conclude that the social function of song are:

- To entertain the listeners.
- To teach moral value through the lyrics of the songs.
- To provide a way of managing the relationship between our public and private emotional life
- To express personal feeling and cultural values.
- To give someone to not only shares their emotions with others, but also to have an emotional connection that just can't be experienced in any other way.

But **in specific**, the Social Function of Song relates to the content of the lyric itself. Or in other words, we can breakdown the Social Function of song in more specific. For example, the song of Black or White by Michael Jackson has the Social Function to talk about equality and fight for racism.
