MATCH ONE HALF OF THE SENTENCE WITH THE OTHER HALF

PRESENT OR FUTURE CONDITION	PAST RESULT
2nd conditional	3rd conditional
If + subject + past simple + , + subject + would have + participle	
<i>If I were rich, I would have bought that house last year.</i>	
(=I'm not rich)	(=I didn't buy that house)

If I were organized and kept a diary...

I would have bought a better present for her

If I didn't know her name...

I would have invited you to our party

If I weren't so busy on Friday night...

I would have remembered that I had a date

If I loved sports and ran everyday...

I would have sang in front of everybody

If I had more money...

I would have asked my friends

If I believed in myself and weren't so shy...

I would have gone to the movies with you

If I you spent more time with us...

I would have participated in the competition
