1. Mountain	a) A barren (бесплодный) area of landscape where little precipitation occurs and living conditions are hostile for plants and animal life.
2. Valley	b) A deep gorge (ущелье) typically with a river flowing it.
3. Desert	c) A large natural elevation of the Earth's surface
4. Canyon	d) A low area between mountains or hills.
5. Bay	e) A mountain or hill typically conical, having a crater or vent (выпускное отверстие) through which lava is erupted.
6. Plateaus	f) A natural underground room in a hillside or cliff.
7. Lake	g) A naturally raised area of land, not very high.
8. Island	h) A piece of land surrounded by water.
9. Landform	i) A slowly moving mass or river of ice formed by the accumulation and compaction of snow on mountains
10. Cave	j) An area of fairly level high ground upland, tableland, elevated plain.
11. Archipelago	k) An area where water flows over a vertical drop or a series of steep drops in the course of a stream or river.
12. Waterfall	l) An extensive (обширный) group of islands or island chain
13. Glacier	m) An natural or artificial feature of the solid surface of the Earth.
14. Peninsular	n) Any of the world's main continuous expanses land.
15. Hill	o) Area filled with water that surrounded by land, apart from any river or other outlet that serves to feed or drain it.
16. Volcano	p) Coasted body of water that directly connected to a larger main body of water such as an ocean, a lake, or another bay.
17. Delta	q) Huge area of water between continents, they cover 72% of our planet.
18. Coast	r) In geography, it's a flat, sweeping landmass that generally doesn't change much in elevation.
19. Continent	s) Large land area surrounded by water on three sides.
