Unit 2: Error Correction

Introduction

This section appears in **Part 2 (Questions 9 to 16)** of Paper 1 in the Bahasa Inggris examination. It tests the candidate's knowledge on grammatical items. In this section, students are given a text with eight underlined errors. Students are required to correct the underlined errors. Having a good grasp in grammar can help students answer this section with ease. This section carries 8 marks.

Strategy to Answer this Question

1. Read through the passage to get a general idea of the text.
2. Identify the tenses used in the passage.
3. Look at the eight underlined errors.
4. Search for clues given in the sentences and words before and after each error.
5. Make sure your answer fits the sentence.

13	with	This is the correct preposition to use with 'armed'.
14	went	The past tense of 'go' is used as the story has already happened.
15	wandering	The past continuous tense form of the verb is required here.
16	man	The noun must be in singular form.
