Working and playing in the world of video games



Many teenagers spend several hours each day playing videos games, but they aren't only playing games, they are creating them, and they are making money doing both.

Roblox is a platform where children can learn to code, design and build their own games and upload them for others to play. Eighteen-year-old Alex Balfanz created two popular games, and he uses the money he makes to pay for university where he's studying computer science. Balfanz's success was possible because Roblox offered a place where he could develop and distribute his games.

People also make money through video games by showing videos of them playing on the internet. Twitch is an online site where users can watch other people playing games, either live or recorded, and it is now one of the most popular websites on the internet.

Another way people make money through video games is by being professional gamers. Many are young people, and they compete in international competitions. In fact, video sports games are so popular that the Olympic committee considered including them in the Olympics, but in the end, they decided not to.
