

A painting by Vincent Van Gogh with an estimated value of up
to £5 million has 1 stolen from a Dutch museum.
The painting stolen was Van Gogh's 'Parsonage Garden at
Nuenen in Spring', and it 2 painted in 1884.
A CCTV camera showed a sledgehammer being used in the raid at the Singer Laren museum in the Netherlands that was closed due 3 the coronavirus pandemic.
The incident happened in the early hours of March 30. The burglar alarm was triggered by the break-in; however, the thieves 4 run away by the time police officers 5
The painting was a loan from another museum, and it was stolen on the day Van Gogh was 6 167 years ago. The painting 7 still missing and no arrests have been made
