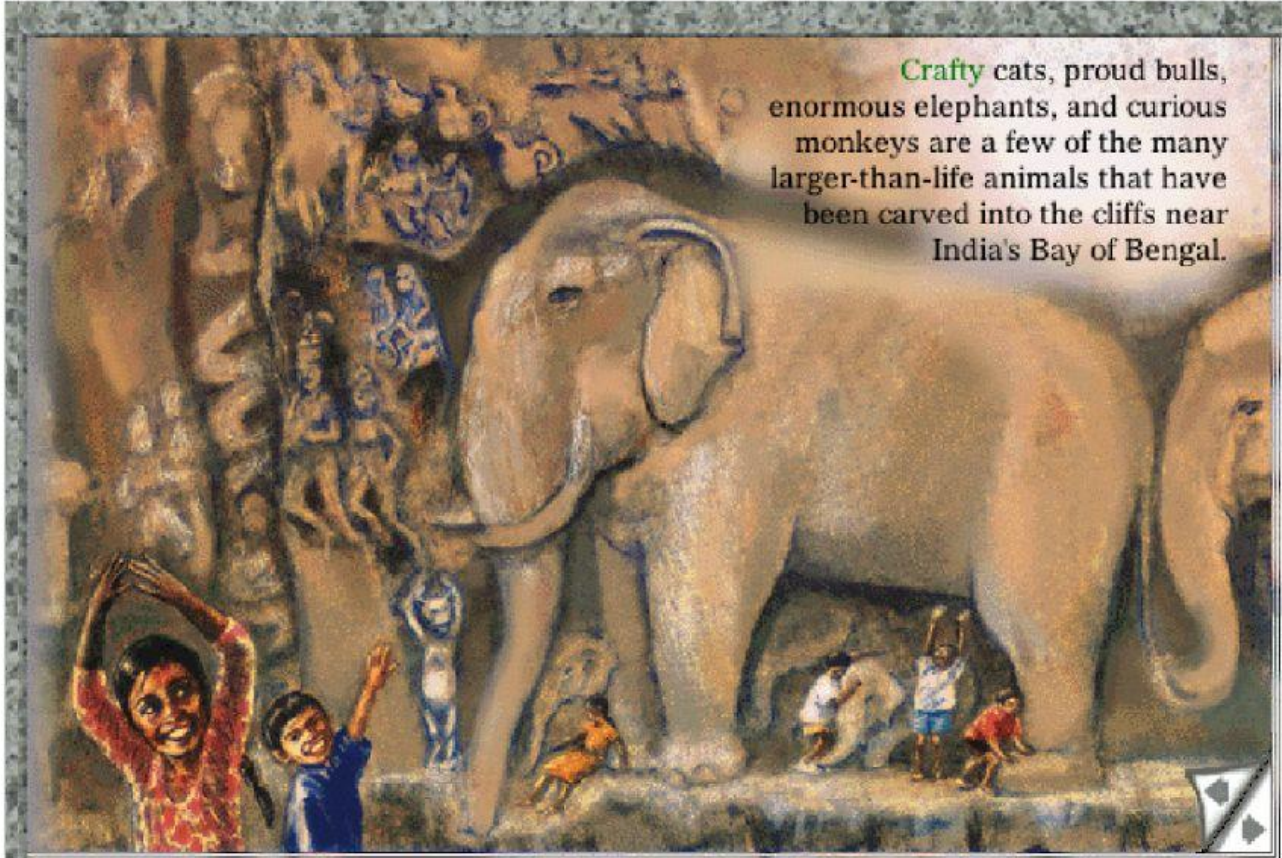
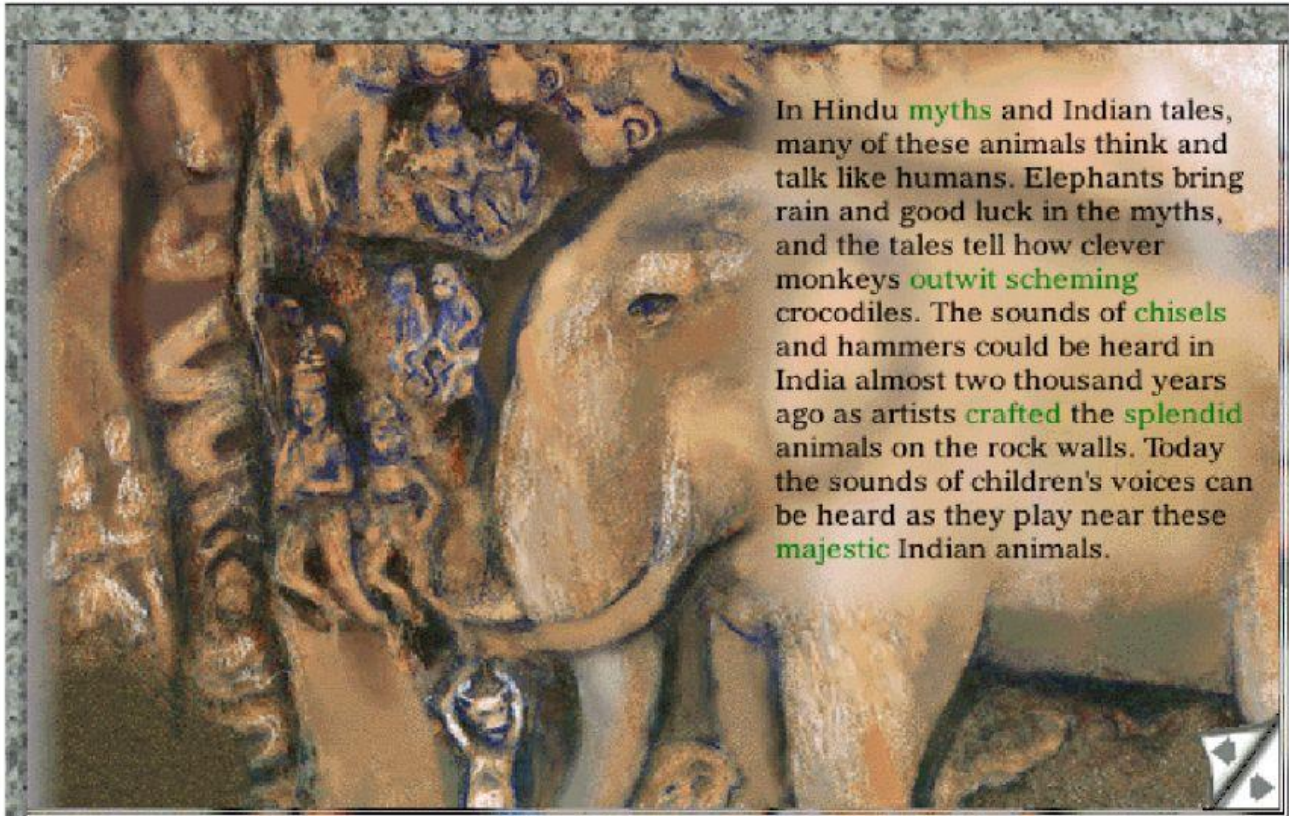


# Animals Carvings, India
