PERSONAL PRONOUNS (it is the subject)	OBJECT PRONOUNS (after the verb)	POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES (before a noun)	POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS (without a noun)
I (yo)	me (me, mi)	my (mi, mis) : my book	mine (mío, -a, míos, -as)
you (tú)	you (te, ti)	your (tu, tus)	yours (tuyo, -a, tuyos, -as)
he (él)	him (a él)	his (su, sus)	his (suyo, -a, -os, -as)
she (ella)	her (a ella)	her (su, sus)	hers (suyo, -a, -os, -as)
it	it	its	its
we (nosotros, nosotras)	us (nos)	our (nuestro, -a, nuestros, -as)	ours (nuestra, -o, -as, -os)
you (vosotros, vosotras)	you (os)	your (vuestro, -a, vuestros, -as)	yours (vuestra, -o, -as, -os)
they (ellos, ellas)	Them (a ellos, ellas)	their (su, sus)	theirs (suyo, -a, -os, -as)
