#### Adjectives to describe films:

#### Match:

Far-fetched

- So exciting that it holds your attention completely.

Predictable

- Happening in a way that you expect, at in uninteresting or unusual way.

Moving /touching

- Frightening

Fast-moving

- Having a strong effect on your emotions, usually so that you feel sadness or sympathy.

Slow-moving

- Thought to be better than it is.

Sentimental

- Extremely unlikely to be true.

Gripping

- Strange, unusual, unexpected or unnatural

Memorable

- Very boring.

Overrated

- When the plot develops quickly.

Underrated

- Dealing with emotions such as love and sadness in a way that seems exaggerated or unrealistic.

Scary

- Likely to be remembered because it is very good, enjoyable or unusual.

Weird

- Thought to be worse than it is.

Hilarious

- When the plot develops slowly.

Tedious

- Fantastic

Corny

- Extremely funny.

Quirky

- Showing no new ideas or too often repeated, and therefore not funny or interesting.

A rave review	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>contains a lot of action or events that happen quickly.</li> </ul>
Cult movie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Extremely upsetting because connected with suffering.</li> </ul>
A pacey / pacy movie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No commercial movie</li> </ul>
Harrowing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(=estrafalario) offbeat; unusual in an attractive and interesting way.</li> </ul>

### Match:

To make a new film that has a story and title similar to an old one.	Sequel
Background music	Soundtrack
A book, film, or play that continues the story of a previous one.	Stunt
The sounds, especially the music, of a film, or a separate recording of this.	Score
The actors in a film, play or show.	Remake
An exciting action that is dangerous and usually needs to be done by someone skilled.	To dub. (Dubbed)
Artificial images that appear real but are created by artists and technical experts.	Cast
To change the sounds and speech on a film especially to a different language.	Leading actor
All the people who work together.	Special effects
Very important or most important	Crew
Not successful	Shoe-string budget
Small	Supporting actor
A blockbuster	A box-office hit
Not the most important actor.	Huge budget
Large in amount	A flop
