Are you  
Is he an architect?  
Is Tanya

Are you  
Are they musicians?  
Are Ted and Jane

## Short answers

Yes, I **am**.  
Yes, he **is**.  
Yes, she **is**.

Yes, we **are**.  
Yes, they **are**.

No, I'm **not**.  
No, he's **not**.  
No, she's **not**.

No, we're **not**.  
No, they're **not**.
