



# QUESTION TAGS

A **question tag** turns a declarative statement or an imperative into a question by adding an interrogative fragment. An example is a question tag is underlined in the following sentence. We are going to the circus, aren't we? When the sentence is **affirmative**, the question tag is **negative**. I like ice cream, don't I? When the sentence is **negative**, the question tag is **affirmative**. I can't eat this last slice of pizza, can I?




