## Forms

- The Present Indefinite Passive — is (am, are) done

*This room is cleaned every other day.*

- The Past Indefinite Passive — was (were) done

*The room was cleaned on Monday.*

- The Future Indefinite Passive — will be done

*The room will be cleaned tomorrow.*

- The Present Continuous Passive — is (are) being done

*The room is being cleaned now.*

- The Past Continuous Passive — was (were) being done

*The room was being cleaned at 6 o'clock yesterday.*

- The Present Perfect Passive — have (has) been done

*The room has already been cleaned.*

- The Past Perfect Passive — had been done

*The room had been cleaned by that time.*

- modals — can (may / might / could / should / must / have to) be done
