Highland High School

Some students can remain in or near Lochaber, taking specialised courses at the West Highland college; but most leave home in Lochaber, and go to cities such as Glasgow, Edinburgh, or Aberdeen.

Many young people in this area feel that there are not enough opportunities here. Going to (11) \_\_\_\_\_ city inevitably means new friends, a whole new lifestyle, and the prospect of a more exciting night life.

Even though Fort William is small and relatively isolated, it is a beautiful place to live. It may not be exciting and incredibly trendy, but that doesn't matter. There is a real community atmosphere here, and many people know, or are related to, many other people. There is always (12) \_\_\_\_\_ to do or see in Fort William; there is no excuse for being (13) \_\_\_\_\_. As far (14) \_\_\_\_\_ I am concerned, it is a great place to live — a beautiful place, with wide open spaces, (15) \_\_\_\_\_ air, peace and quiet, and magnificent scenery. It is an area full of myths and legends — some of them true, others pure invention! But there is one thing that is certainly not "Scotch mist", and that is Highland hospitality. It is still very real, very alive!
