
Jane worked with Paul. "Bears are great", Paul said. Let's find a picture of a bear in a river. They're really good at catching fish! Or a lion? People are of those.

Let's find a picture of a lion with its mouth open! I like seeing its big teeth.


"What about kangaroos?" Jane said. They have longer and stronger tails than bears or lions. It's their tails that make them really good at!


