Example: in a castle on Middle Age |
| 2. Script | <input type="checkbox"/> A story performed by actors on a stage |
| 3. Cast (cast of characters) | <input type="checkbox"/> All characters of the story who are played by actors |
| 4. Setting | <input type="checkbox"/> The text of the play, in which you find the whole story |
| 5. Narrator | <input type="checkbox"/> An action that takes place in a single setting |
| 6. Scene | <input type="checkbox"/> An interaction between two characters |
| 7. Dialogue | <input type="checkbox"/> The person who tells what's happening during the play |
| 8. Stage directions | <input type="checkbox"/> Inscriptions written between brackets () that tell the characters where to go and what to do and that don't need to be written |
