1. We would have arrived here late if Neil's father hadn't taken us to the bus stop. **FOR**

Had Neil's father taking us to the bus stop, we would have arrived here late.
(for it been not)

2. If Maurice hadn't told Beth about that letter, we wouldn't have argued. **FOR**

Had telling Beth about that letter, we wouldn't have argued.
(for it been not)

3. I only told you because I thought you would be interested. **TOLD**

I you if I thought you weren't interested. (have wouldn't told)

4. I won't organise the party unless you arrange the food. **LONG**

I'll organise the party arrange the food. (you long as as)

5. If you do the washing up I'll make the coffee. **PROVIDED**

I'll make the coffee the washing up. (that you do provided)

6. The reason I haven't got much money is because they didn't give me promotion. **POOR**

If they had given me promotion I now. (poor be wouldn't)

7. If she doesn't come on time, we'll go without her. **UNLESS**

....., we will go without her. (comes unless time on she)

8. I won't help you if you don't do your best. **UNLESS**

I won't help you.....your best. (do you unless)

9. Behave yourself or everyone will dislike you. **UNLESS**

Everyoneyourself. (behave dislike will unless you you)

10. If it wasn't for the good pay, I wouldn't stay in this job. **BUT**

....., I wouldn't stay in this job. (the pay but good for)

11. Read the question carefully or you may answer it incorrectly. **LONG**

Youthe questions carefully. (correctly will it as as you long read answer)

If I were you, I would borrow the money. **BETTER**

12. Youthe money. (better had borrow)
