### A. Possessive Adjectives

	Singular	Plural	
1 <sup>st</sup> Person	I have a dog. This is <b>my</b> dog.	We have a new house. This is <b>our</b> house.	• I - my • we - our
2 <sup>nd</sup> Person	You have a present. This is <b>your</b> present.	You are good singers. I like <b>your</b> voices.	• you - your
3 <sup>rd</sup> Person	John has a new bike. This is <b>his</b> bike. Mary has a blue jacket. This is <b>her</b> jacket.	My friends play basketball. These are <b>their</b> uniforms.	• he - his • she - her • it - its
	A giraffe has a long neck. <b>Its</b> legs are long too.	Elephants have big ears. <b>Their</b> trunks are strong.	• they - their

- My, our, your, his, her, its, and their are possessive adjectives.
- A possessive adjective is used in front of a noun: my dog, our house, their uniforms

**B. Possessive Pronouns**

	<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>	
<b>1<sup>st</sup> Person</b>	This is my backpack. This backpack is <b>mine</b> .	This is our house. This house is <b>ours</b> .	• I - my - mine • we - our - ours
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Person</b>	This is your book. This book is <b>yours</b> .	These are <b>your</b> games. These games are <b>yours</b> .	• you - your - yours
<b>3<sup>rd</sup> Person</b>	This is his camera. This camera is <b>his</b> . This is her computer. This computer is <b>hers</b> .	This is their car. This car is <b>theirs</b> .	• he - his - his • she - her - hers • they - their - theirs

- Mine, ours, yours, his, hers, and theirs are possessive pronouns.
- Possessive pronoun = possessive adjective + noun (mine = my backpack)
- Whose asks about possession. Whose book is this? It's my book. / It's mine.
