Osaka Castle is one of the best known castles in Japan. It was built in 1583 by Hideyoshi Toyotomi, a powerful lord and warrior during the Sengoku period. Hideyoshi liked gold very much, so he decided to decorate the furniture inside the castle with gold. The exteriors of the castle were also decorated with gold leaves. Many wars broke out and during them, the castle was destroyed and rebuilt many times. In 1665, the castle tower was also destroyed by fire after it was struck by lightning. The most recent year when Osaka Castle was rebuilt was in 1928. Surviving the Second World War with little damage, the structure was recognized as a historic site by the Japanese Government in the 1950s.
