AGREEING TO DISAGREE

Life would be boring if we all agreed all the time. The following phrases let you state your position clearly while keeping the conversation friendly. Read all phrases aloud.

Expressing agreement ...or disagreement

I agree.	I don't agree.
That's right.	Sorry, I disagree.
Absolutely.	I can't go along with that.
That's true.	That's not completely true.
I believe that.	I don't believe that.
That's a good idea.	That's quite a stretch.
That's right on target.	That's way off base.
That's valid.	That's invalid.
I accept that.	I can't accept that. I reject that.
I partly agree.	I think you are wrong here.
I support that.	I can't support that.
That idea has my vote.	I have a different idea./I have a better idea.
I definitely agree.	I beg to differ.
I strongly agree.	That doesn't make sense. Is that logical?
I couldn't agree more.	That seems simplistic.
	I see things differently.
	That's not always true.
	On the contrary.

Seeking clarification

Sometimes we need more information. Use these phrases:

So? What do you mean?

Can you rephrase that? Why do you say that?

Can you give another example? Have you considered...?

What if the situation were a bit different? What if...?

Do you think that is the only reason/cause/explanation? How far would you go?

Are you sure? Why are you so sure?

What's your source for that bit of information? How do you know?

Can you imagine some alternatives? Is there another possibility?
