

We use **so.....that....** when we talk about the result of something. We use **so** before an adjective or adverb.

- The house was **so** expensive **that** my father couldn't buy it.
- The book was **so** interesting **that** I wanted to read it again.
- Türkiye is **so** beautiful **that** thousands of tourists visit every year.

We use **such.... that....** with adjective + noun.

- He is **such** a good boy **that** everybody likes him.
- They are **such** interesting animals **that** everybody wants to see them.
- She is **such** a careless student **that** she makes a lot of mistakes.
