

Present Simple 1:

VERB TO BE:

I	AM
You	ARE
He/she/it	IS
We	ARE
You	ARE
They	ARE

VERB CAN:

I	CAN
You	CAN
He/she/it	CAN
We	CAN
You	CAN
They	CAN

Affirmative	SUBJECT + VERB TO BE + OBJECTS.	
	Example: I am happy. Sue is very tall.	
Interrogative	VERB TO BE + SUBJECT + OBJECTS + ?	
	Example: Am I happy? Is Sue very tall?	
Tip:	Sam is hungry. Is Sam hungry?	
Negative	SUBJECT + VERB TO BE + NOT + OBJECTS.	
	Example: I am not happy. Sue is not very tall.	
Contractions: I + am = I'm we + are = we're they + are = they're		Contractions: is + not = isn't are + not = aren't

Affirmative	SUBJECT + CAN + OBJECTS.	
	Example: I can swim. Lisa can speak three languages.	
Interrogative	VERB CAN + SUBJECT + OBJECTS + ?	
	Example: Can I swim? Can Lisa speak three languages?	
Tip:	I can swim. Can I swim?	
Negative	SUBJECT + VERB CAN + NOT + OBJECTS.	
	Example: I cannot swim. Lisa cannot speak three languages.	
Contractions: can + not = can't
