

PAST SIMPLE

1. To talk about an action or situation in the past which is finished. We often say when it happened.




I studied German for 2 years.

2. Chronological activities in the past.

Today, I woke up at 5 am, I took a shower, I brushed my teeth, and dressed up.

Time expressions:

- yesterday • in the morning • in 1963
- two days ago • this morning • last year

 + verb past + rest	PRESENT (infinitive)	PAST
+) I sang in the shower this morning.	sing	sang
+) She went to the park yesterday.	go	went
 + did not + verb simple form + rest.	need	needed
-) I did not sing in the shower this morning.	travel	travelled
-) She didn't go to the park yesterday. (did not = didn't)		
Did +  + verb s.f. + rest?		
?) Did I sing in the shower in the morning?		
Yes, I did. / No, I didn't.		
?) Did she go to the park yesterday?		
Yes, she did. / No, she didn't.		
Why did I go to the park yesterday? Because my dog needed to go to the park.		
Where did you go yesterday? I went to the park.
