

## Exercise 6

Read the information. Then read the sentences. Why is the modal verb used in each one? Choose the correct explanation for each sentence.

### Modal verbs of obligation

- Strong positive obligations: *must; have/has to; need to*
- Weak obligations: *should*
- Strong negative obligations: *mustn't*
- No obligation (optional): *don't need to / don't have to*
- Positive advice: *should*
- Negative: *shouldn't*

A choice whether to do something or not.      Advice about the best thing to do.

Advice about what not to do .      An obligation not to do something.

An obligation to do something.
