A **genre** is a category or type of artistic work with a particular style, form, or content.


What Kind of Story?

Realistic Fiction

Setting: the present

Plot: events that could happen in real life



Historical Fiction

Setting: the past

Plot: the way events in real life could have happened

Mystery

Setting: usually the past or present

Plot: the solving of a puzzle, usually a crime

Fantasy

Setting: usually a world that is full of magic


Plot: often involves a quest or a battle between forces of good and evil

Science Fiction

Setting: usually the future or an outer space world

Plot: often involves a quest or battle with elements based on scientific theories
