

What is SER?

Introductory Vocabulary:

Conjugate: To change the form of the verb based on who the subject is.

Infinitive: The verb in its original, unchanged form.

Subject Pronouns: Who you are talking about. Yo, Tu, El, Ella, Ellos, Usted, Ustedes, Nosotros, Vosotros.

Ser = To be (permanent, not temporary)

-There are 6 different conjugations of any verb (for the 6 subject pronouns)

Conjugation of the verb ser **ser = to be**

(yo)	soy	(nosotros) (nosotras)	somos
(tú)	eres	(vosotros) (vosotras)	sois
Ud. (él) (ella)	es	Uds. (ellos) (ellas)	son

When conjugating, you **FIRST** look at the **SUBJECT PRONOUN** to determine the subject.

Subject Pronoun + Verb in correct form Ex. **Yo + soy** **Tú + eres** **El/Ella/Usted + es**

Ser is used to express D.O.T.S:

D – day/date **O** – Origin/Occupation **T** – Time **S** – Special Qualities
