Scout for a location: it is important to find a suitable location to begin filming.

Select a camera: it is possible to use an iOS or Android device to make a short film and even a few successful feature films have been shot using only a smart phone.

Edit the film: for short films many of the free software packages usually suffice. Windows, for example, comes with Windows Live Movie Maker, which has stood the test of time for years.

How to Make a Pancake Cake

Ingredients:

- 100 grams glutinous rice flour
- 100 grams grated old coconut
- 50 grams flour
- 200 ml thick coconut milk
- 200 ml water
- 1 egg

- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- Cooking oil to taste

Instructions:

1. Mix flour and coconut milk until thickened. Then stir until smooth.
2. Then, mix the glutinous rice flour and grated coconut with the mixture which is already ripe. Add egg and salt, then mix well. After that, pour a little water slowly while you stir.
3. After that, heat up pancong cake mold and spread with oil. Then, enter the dough into the mold.
4. Then, close the mold and grilled over low heat until cooked through. Afterwards, remove from the mold carefully. Serve it warm.

Note: If you want it to be more delicious, you can add some sugar over the pancong cake when half-cooked.

How to Make a Photo Frame

Tools:

- A pair of scissors
- An OHP (Over Head Projector) sheet/transparency
- A knife
- Satin tapes (min two colors)
- A cardboard sheet (Here, 3 mm thickness)
- Glue

The steps:

1. Trace the outline of a photograph onto your cardboard sheet making sure it's in the center.
2. Now, using a knife carefully cut out the area within the traced outline.
3. Starting from the top left corner, apply glue all along the breadth of the top frame until where the right frame and the top frame share a common area as shown in the figure.
4. This space gives room for us to tuck the tapes which will cover the right frame under the top frame.
5. Paste the OHP sheet behind the open square.
6. Paste a colored sheet behind your frame. Score along the length and breadth of the size of the photograph in order that you may be able to insert your pictures.
7. Make sure the above step is done before pasting the colored paper onto the frame.

Bread Ingredients:

Indonesian Jamu: A Simple Recipe to Make Your Own Healing Detox Tonic

Here's what you'll need to get started:

- 2-4 fresh turmeric roots (or 1-2 teaspoons organic turmeric powder)
- 1 small galangal root (or knob of ginger)
- 1 tablespoon tamarind pulp
- 1 liter drinking water
- Honey to taste

How to make:

1. Peel and grate the turmeric and galangal (or ginger).
2. Boil the turmeric and galangal (or ginger) in water for approximately half an hour, till it becomes slightly creamy; add more water if the concoction starts looking a bit dry.
3. Cool for a few minutes, then pour it into a blender, add the tamarind and honey; blend until frothy.
4. Strain and serve warm; or refrigerate in an airtight bottle.
