Rosalind Franklin

Rosalind Franklin was a scientist who invented a way of photographing DNA in 1952. DNA is a special molecule that is in every cell of your body. It has all of the instructions for your body to work and grow.

Rosalind Franklin's invention changed science because it helped scientists to learn more about DNA and our bodies. The scientists that she worked with were men – they were given the Nobel Prize for Science but Rosalind Franklin was not.

Shirley Jackson

In 1973, Shirley Jackson was the first black woman to earn a PhD (which is a very important diploma) from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (a very important school).
