should ความจำเป็น ควรจะ ใช้เพื่อใช้คำแนะนำ หรือแสดงความคิดเห็น

โครงสร้าง Subject + should + v. infinitive

ตัวอย่าง: You should get up early. (คุณควรตื่นตอนเช้า)

Shouldn't ความจำเป็น "ไม่ควร" ควรใช้: ใช้เป็นปฏิเสธ

โครงสร้าง: Subject + should + not + v. infinitive

ตัวอย่าง: He shouldn't tell me a lie. (เขากำลังจะโกหกฉัน)

การใช้ Should เป็นประโยคคำถาย

โครงสร้าง: Should + Subject+ v. infinitive ?

Wh-question+should + Subject+ v. infinitive ?

ตัวอย่าง: Should I buy this one? (ฉันควรซื้อหนึ่งชิ้นหรือเปล่า)

Vocabulary: Grammar ; should-shouldn't

- **obey (v.):** to carry out or fulfill the command, order, or instruction of (ทำตาม)
- **mess (n.):** a cluttered, untidy, usually dirty place or condition (สภาพครุยรัง)
- **garbage (n.):** waste material, such as paper, empty containers and food thrown away (ขยะ)
- **baggage (n.):** the trunks, bags, parcels, and suitcases in which one carries one's belongings while traveling; luggage (กระเป๋าเดินทาง)
- **valuable (adj.):** having considerable monetary or material value for use or exchange (มีมูลค่า)
- **suitcase (n.):** a portable rectangular container for carrying clothes (กระเป๋าเดินทาง)
- **stranger (n.):** a person who is new to a particular locality, from another region, town, etc. (คนแปลกหน้า)
- **roommate (n.):** a person with whom one shares a room or rooms (เพื่อนร่วมห้อง)
- **snore (v.):** to breathe noisily through your mouth and nose while you are asleep (กรุ๊)
