- **occasion (n.):** an important social event or ceremony (โอกาส)
- **college (n.):** a school for advanced education, especially in a particular profession or skill (วิทยาลัย)
- **entrance (n.):** permission to become a member of or become involved in a profession, university, society, etc. (การสอบเข้ามหาวิทยาลัย, ลักษณะในการเข้า)
- **score (n.):** a number of points, goals, etc. made by a player or team in a game; or gained in a competition, etc. (แต้มในการเล่นกีฬา)
- **celebrate (v.):** to do something enjoyable because it is a special occasion or because something good has happened (เฉลิมฉลอง)
- **gown (n.):** a long loose piece of clothing worn for special ceremonies by judges, teachers, lawyers, and member of universities (ชุดครุย)
- **graduation (n.):** a time when you complete a university degree course or your education at an American high school (การจบการศึกษา)
- **theme (n.):** a particular style (แนว)
- **braces (n.):** a device that people put on their teeth to make them straight (เข็มคลัծฟัน)
- **reception (n.):** a large formal party (การเลี้ยงต้อนรับ, การรับรองแขก)
- **honeymoon (n.):** a vacation taken by two people after they are married (การฉลองสมรส)
