### When and How long Questions

With <b>be</b>	When is the festival?	It's in July / on Thursday. It starts <b>on</b> July 1 / <b>at</b> 10:00.
	How long is the festival?	(It's) <b>from</b> July 1 <b>to</b> July 3. (It lasts) <b>until</b> July 3 / <b>for</b> three days.
With other verbs	When do you study?	(I study) <b>on</b> Saturdays / <b>in</b> the evening.
	How long do you study?	(I study) <b>from</b> 4:00 <b>to</b> 6:00 / <b>until</b> 6:00 / <b>for</b> an hour.
