

A real-life hero

Chesley Sully Sullenberger is a real-life hero. He worked as a pilot for US Airways. On January 15, 2009, he flew the 1549 flight from LaGuardia Airport in New York. There were 155 people on the plane. A few minutes after takeoff, some big birds flew into the plane, and the engines stopped. The plane started to go down quickly. Sully had to land immediately, but he couldn't go back to LaGuardia because he didn't have enough time. Sully looked down and saw the Hudson River below the plane. He decided to land there. Landing a plane on water is very difficult and dangerous, but Sully kept calm. Without the noise of the engine, it was very quiet inside the plane. Everyone was very frightened. When the tail of the plane touched the water, Sully brought the nose down carefully. The plane continued along the top of the water, but finally it stopped. Luckily, it floated, and everyone was rescued. The movie "Sully" starring Tom Hanks is based on this real event.
