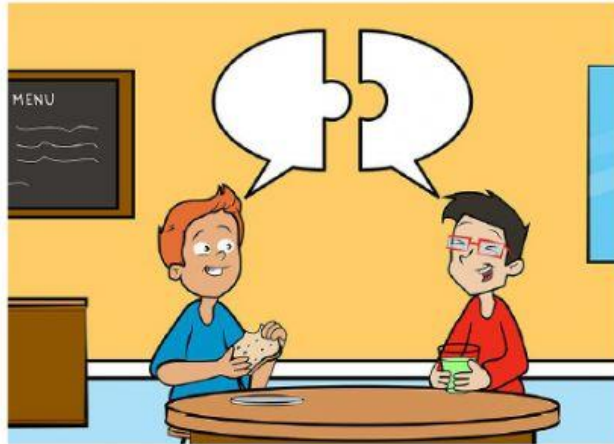




RECORD THE SENTENCES **IN BOLD** PAYING ATTENTION TO THE ED PRONUNCIATION FOR EACH CASE.
