This week, the four barbers working at "The Barberians" have appointments on different days, with different clients and for different services. Using the clues and the grid below, match each barber to the client, the day, and the service of the appointment and complete the barbershop's planner. No option in any category is used more than once. In the grid drag & drop a ✓ to mark a box as "yes" and select it (by clicking on it) to mark it as "no".



CLUES



- 1) Mr Brown's appointment is earlier in the week than Luke's appointment.
- 2) The Monday appointment is not for a haircut.
- 3) The haircut is either the Thursday appointment or for Grant's client.
- 4) Mark either has Mr Cooper as his client or the Tuesday appointment.
- 5) Luke's appointment is 2 days before the moustache trim.
- 6) Of Luke and Mr Smith, one has an appointment on Wednesday and the other an appointment for beard care.
