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| 1. Sell (verb) | () to sell in large quantities |
| 2. Seller (noun) | () a statement that a situation is unsatisfactory or unacceptable. |
| 3. Purchase (verb) | () The action of giving money to obtain/get a product. |
| 4. Buyer (noun) | () available for immediate sale in a store. |
| 5. Negotiate (verb) | () The person who paid to have the item/product |
| 6. Exchange (verb) | () The person who sold the product. |
| 7. Refund (Verb-noun) | () A conversation where each person or side involved agrees to a specific price for an item. |
| 8. Guarantee(verb-noun) | () to swap one thing for another thing |
| 9. Lowest price (adj.) | () When the money used to buy something is returned to the buyer. |
| 10. Cash(noun) | () a deduction from the usual cost of something |
| 11. In stock (adj.) | () to sell in small quantities |
| 12. Out-of-stock (adj) | () To give a product in exchange for money |
| 13. Discount (noun) | () A promise that something will do as described, or will be replaced, repaired in case the product does not do as described. |
| 14. Retail (noun) | () to have a lower price on a product than anyone else. |
| 15. Wholesale (noun) | () money in coins or notes |
| 16. Complaint (noun) | () unavailable for immediate sale in a store. |
