
<b>prisoner's dilemma</b>	one of the branches of science, devoted to the study of societies and the relationships among individuals within those societies.
<b>Social Darwinism</b>	a situation where two parties, separated and unable to communicate, must each choose between cooperating with the other or not.
<b>Darwin's theory</b>	is an ability to see the context which shapes your individual decision making, as well as the decisions made by others.
<b>Social sciences</b>	“survival of the fittest”—the idea that certain people become powerful in society because they are innately better.
<b>Social imagination</b>	species can change over time, that new species come from pre-existing species, and that all species share a common ancestor.
<b>Kropotkin's theory</b>	cooperation within a species has been an historical factor in the development of social institutions, and in fact, that the avoidance of competition greatly increases the chances of survival and raises the quality of life.
