### Questions

<b>Do</b>	I	<b>play tennis?</b>
	you	
	we	
	you they	

### Short answers

Yes, I/you/we/you/they do.

No, I/you/we/you/they don't.

Use *do* with the simple present to form questions.

Affirmative form	→	Question form
<i>They live in Boston.</i>	→	<i>Do they live in Boston?</i> ✓
		<i>They live in Boston?</i> ✗

### Short answers

Yes, they do. ✓

No, they don't. ✓

Yes, they live. ✗

No, they don't live. ✗
