4 bad eating habits and how to fix them

As teens grow and develop, it's normal for them to feel hungrier and start to eat more. Extra food gives them extra energy and the nutrients to support their growth. Teens also start changing their eating habits. 1 Sadly, they don't seem to realise how bad their diets are and that it isn't healthy to have biscuits for breakfast and burgers for lunch. Here are the four worst food habits of teens and how to fix them.

Skipping breakfast

One of the worst eating habits is skipping breakfast.

2 Eating breakfast helps with weight control, affects a teen's mood and their performance at school. It's important that parents make it part of their routine to put breakfast on the table and sit with their teens while they enjoy a healthy breakfast.

Dining out often

Teens visit fast food restaurants as much for the food as for the social life. 3 Or maybe they can't have lunch or dinner at home because of football practice or music lessons. Teenagers need to realise they can have fast food once a week. Parents need to make dinner and healthy food available to them when they have the time. When hungry teens get home from sports practice or whatever activity they enjoy, they can simply heat this food up.

Too many soft drinks

Research into the eating habits of young Americans has shown that soft drinks remain a favourite among teens.



4 They can develop healthier habits by drinking fruit juice and water and not buying soda or cola. They can try low-sugar alternatives that still offer flavour and sweetness but don't have as many calories.

Preference for high-calorie snacks

Fats, oils and sweets are at the top of the food pyramid. This group is filled with foods that may threaten your health. Teens develop a preference for these foods as they grow older. Quite often, eating too much from this group doesn't allow enough healthy foods into their diet. The only way young people can break this habit is by having fruit and healthy snacks available. Not having snacks that are high in fat and calories is also helpful. 5

Out of all age groups, a teenager's growing body requires the most energy. Teenage boys should consume up to 3,200 calories per day on average. Teenage girls should consume up to 2,400 daily calories on average. This much-needed energy should come from superfoods like berries, nuts, fish, beans and yoghurt. Parents should stock the kitchen with healthy food and be good role models in order to monitor their teens' eating habits.
