Verb ending in...	How to make the simple past	Examples
e če se glagol konča na -e	Add -D	live → lived date → dated
Consonant + y soglasnik + y	Change y to i, then add -ED	try → tried cry → cried
One vowel + one consonant (but NOT w or y) samoglasnik + soglasnik	Double the consonant, then add -ED	tap → tapped commit → committed
anything else including w vsi ostali glagoli dobijo -ed	Add -ED	boil → boiled fill → filled hand → handed show → showed
