
## UNIT 6. TIMELINE

A **timeline** is a way of visually show the different Ages of History. They are usually divided into 2 main parts, Before Christ (B.C.) and Annus Domini (A. D.).

## It usually shows:

- The name of the historical period
- The starting and finishing year of each period
- Some of them include pictures that can help you remember the main events occurred in each period.



The main historical periods are: Prehistory (before writing was invented), Ancient History (includes great civilizations such as Ancient Egypt, Ancient Greece, Ancient China and Ancient Rome), Middle Ages, Modern Age and Present Age.
