to do something, sometimes something that you should not do

check up on

to find out information about someone, especially secretly

get away with

to manage to do something bad without being punished or criticised for it

get through to

to make someone understand what you are trying to say

get up to

to do something, especially something that you should not do

grow out of

if someone grows out of a habit, they stop doing it, because they are older or wiser

live up to

to be as good as what was expected or promised

look down on

to think that you are better or more important than someone else, or to think that something is not good enough for you

look up to

to admire and respect someone

put together

to produce or organise something using many different things

stand up for

to defend someone or something that is being criticised or attacked
