Tag Questions

Tag questions are used to check information. With an affirmative sentence, use a negative tag. With a negative sentence, use an affirmative tag.

Affirmative Sentence / Negative Tag

Your name is Bob Wilson, **isn't it?**
You're from England, **aren't you?**
You were born in London, **weren't you?**
You live in Amsterdam, **don't you?**
You studied in Oxford, **didn't you?**
You've been an actor, **haven't you?**

Negative Sentence / Affirmative Tag

She isn't Spanish, **is she?**
It isn't her first movie, **is it?**
She wasn't born in Rio, **was she?**
She doesn't speak English, **does she?**
She didn't work in a bank, **did she?**
She hasn't lived in the U.S., **has she?**
