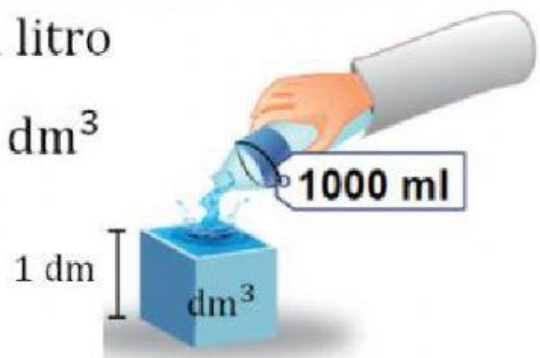
Unidades de volumen y de capacidad

$$1\,000\text{ ml} = 1\text{ litro}$$

$$1\text{ litro} = 1\text{ dm}^3$$

$$1\text{ dm} = 0.1\text{ m}$$

$$1\text{ dm} = 10\text{ cm}$$
