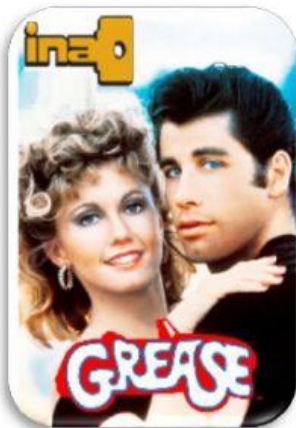

But, oh

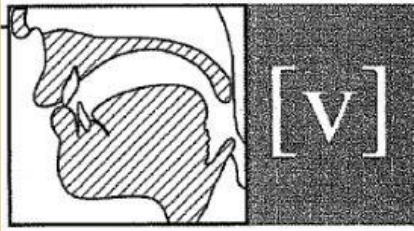

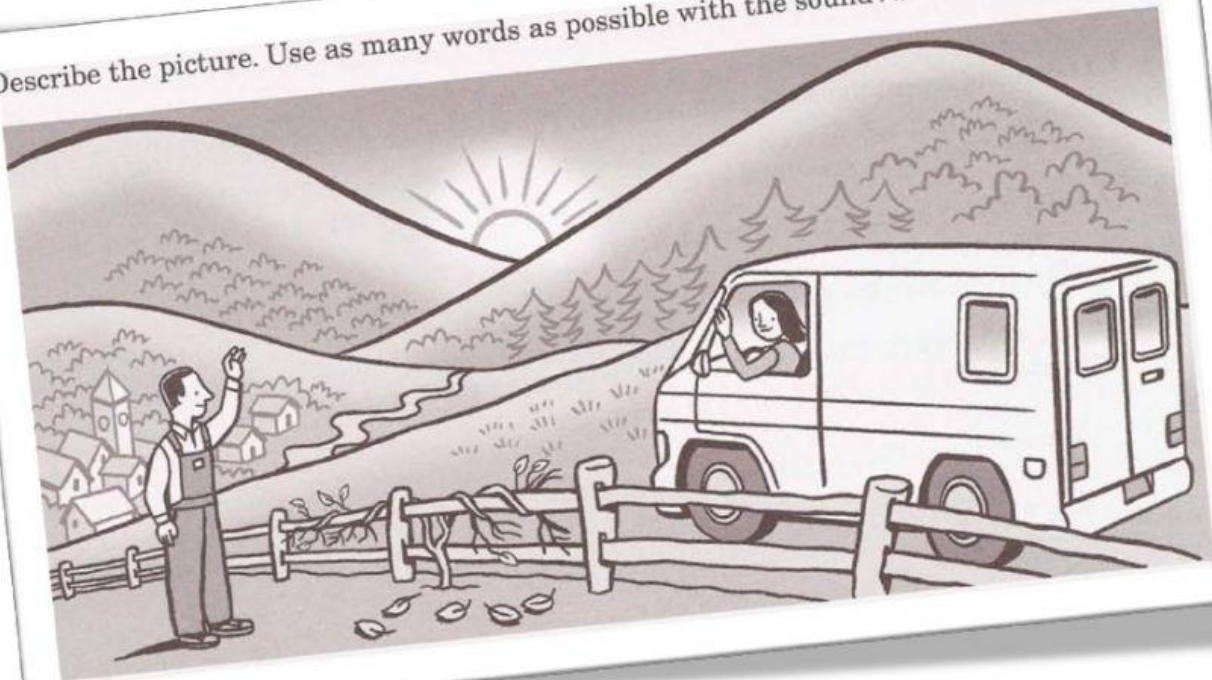
