This critically endangered mammal lives in Africa. It has got a large **horn** near its nose and a smaller horn behind it. It likes lying in water to protect its **skin** from insects and the sun. What animal is it?



This **harmless** giant lives in Asia. It's famous for its long **trunk** and beautiful **tusks**. It's **protected** because people (*poachers*) kill it for its tusks. What animal is it?



This amphibian is now an **invasive** species in many countries. Originally from Central and South America, it multiplies quickly and it hasn't got many predators, because its skin is **poisonous**. What animal is it?
